As required by Section 6033 of the Internal Revenue Code, CAVC estimates that the nondeductible portion of 2009 dues - the portion which is allocable to lobbying - is 100%. Therefore, only dues less that percentage may be deducted by you as an ordinary and necessary business expense for your 2009 tax year.
