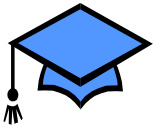

RULES

1. This \$2,500 post high school scholarship will be presented by the **Walsh Family CAVC Scholarship Foundation** annually.
2. The student must maintain and verify a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.5 on a 4.0 scale or equivalent.
3. The student must be a full time high school senior or full time college student at an accredited vocational school, accredited business college, junior college, four year college or graduate school.
4. The student must be an American citizen, a California resident, and be sponsored by a CAVC member company.
5. Family income or college major are not determinants.
6. \$1250 of the scholarship will be forwarded in the student's name to the college of choice, prior to registration, for classes in the Fall semester. The second \$1250 will be forwarded to the college, prior to registration, for the second semester upon verification that the recipient has maintained a cumulative grade point average of at least a 2.0 on a 4.0 scale in the first semester.
7. The scholarship is good only for the academic year in which it is awarded and will be forfeited if the student does not attend school beginning in the Fall semester.
8. Applicants may reapply each year for as long as they are eligible. (An applicant may only win once).
9. Every CAVC member company whose dues are paid in full may submit two applicants. Member companies who wish to submit additional applicants may submit one additional name for each \$350 donation to the Scholarship Foundation fund.
10. Every CAVC member company shall be responsible for abiding by the Foundation rules when screening and submitting potential candidates.
11. Each applicant must fill out this application and each CAVC member company shall submit its choices annually. Applications must be postmarked by the **DEADLINE** date of **April 7, 2010**
12. The names of all qualified applicants will be placed in a box and winners drawn by lot at the CAVC Board of Directors Meeting held in conjunction with the NAMA Spring Expo in April.
13. The Walsh Family CAVC Scholarship Foundation Board of Directors shall meet prior to the drawing and determine the number of scholarships to be given that year.
