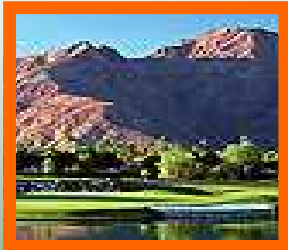

Legislative Summit

JOB AND THE ECONOMY, IMMIGRATION, HEALTH CARE REFORM, TAXES, ARIZONA AND CALIFORNIA BUDGET ISSUES

This year with the upcoming November elections and all of the issues pending at the federal and state level we will be focusing on Government Affairs. In keeping with this focus we will be holding a Legislative Summit on Saturday with federal, state and local speakers addressing a wide variety of topics that are relevant to citizens in California and Arizona and the vending industry on the federal and state level.

Confirmed speakers include:

TONY STRICKLAND, Republican Candidate for California State Controller

Yes on California Proposition 26 Campaign spokesperson. Proposition 26 will require a two-thirds vote of the Legislature to pass almost all state fees and certain taxes, which currently require only a majority vote.

NED MONROE, NAMA Vice President Government Affairs

Ned will discuss the health care reform bill and its effect on business with an emphasis on the calorie disclosure requirements for the vending industry, and other key issues affecting our industry.

In addition we will have updates from our Arizona Legislative Consultant Elaine Arena, and California Legislative Consultant Jennifer Snyder.
